The SQA is the national awarding body in Scotland responsible for the development, accreditation, assessment, certification and awarding of qualifications other than University Degrees. SQA was established by the Education (Scotland) Act 1996, which is an act of Parliament and, as such, is responsible to the Scottish Government.

As an internationally recognised awarding body, many quality-assured qualifications certified by SQA are accepted by International Universities for advanced entry and/or credit transfer into Undergraduate and Postgraduate Programmes.

Programme Structure

SCQF Level 11 International Professional Diploma in Business Management is a flexible postgraduate programme in business with opportunities to specialise in one of the Eight Pathways offered.

SCQF Level 11 qualification allows learners to study core subjects of Strategic management skills and research skills along with their choice of specialisation.

Learners who can evidence prior learning from similar business-related programmes at the same level and with similar credit size units may be admitted under the Recognition of Prior Learning Arrangements.

To complete ISDC's Qualification, students must complete the three core modules of Level 11, in which students can choose any of the eight career-focused pathways per their interests and aspirations.
